Introduction

- 1. Is your love <u>GENUINE</u>? v. 9a 9a Let love be without hypocrisy.
 - Trying to make our outsides look better than the insides. 1 Cor. 13:3, Matt. 15:7
 - Trying to hide our own faults by drawing attention to others. Luke 6:42;
 Luke 13:14,15
 - Trying to get approval of other people. Matt. 6:2, 5

Take away from me the noise of your songs; to the melody of your harps I will not listen. But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream. Amos 5:23,24

For he has made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. 2 Cor. 5:21

2. Is your love <u>PASSIONATE</u>? v. 9b 9b Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.

Be angry but do not sin. Eph. 4:26

Learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, plead the widow's cause. Isa. 1:17

Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves; ensure justice for those being crushed. Yes, speak up for the poor and helpless, and see that they get justice. Prov. 31:8-9

3. Is your love DEVOTED? v. 10-12

10 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; 11 not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; 12 rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer.

There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. Gal. 3:28

Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain. 1 Cor. 15:58

- Who are some specific people you'd like to focus loving in a more Christ-like way? What is the first thing you will do to live out your love today?
