1. "God waited patiently"

God's perspective on mercy

- Romans 2:4, Rom. 9:22, 1 Tim.1:16
- 2 Peter 3:9
- ✓ We are ambassadors of God's mercy, even when they don't respond.
- 2. "in the days of Noah"

God's perspective on a resistant audience

- Gen 6:5, Jonah, The ark, a reminder of God's judgement & love, Ezekiel 33:11,
 2 Cor 5: 11 (fear) & 14 (love)
- ✓ We let God's judgement & His love drive us when we feel resistance.
- 3. "while the ark was being built"

God's perspective on time

- 2 Peter 3:8-9
- ✓ We let God set the timetable with people when it seems slow & pray!
- 4. "In which only a few people, eight in all, were saved"

God's perspective on results

- · Luke 13:23-24
- Matt 7:13-14
- Luke 15: 1-32
- ✓ We leave the results with God when the numbers seem small.

Discussion Questions for Session 2

- 1. How patient and merciful are you with the difficult or even vulgar people in your world?
- 2. Do you have something (an object lesson, key verse, etc.) that keeps God's judgement and His love motivating you to reach out to the lost?
- 3. Are you persisting in prayer even though the response or progress of someone you are sharing with seems slow?
- 4. How many people have found Christ through your life? If the answer is "small", how do you keep a balance between feeling guilty and giving up and feeling concerned and trying to do more?
